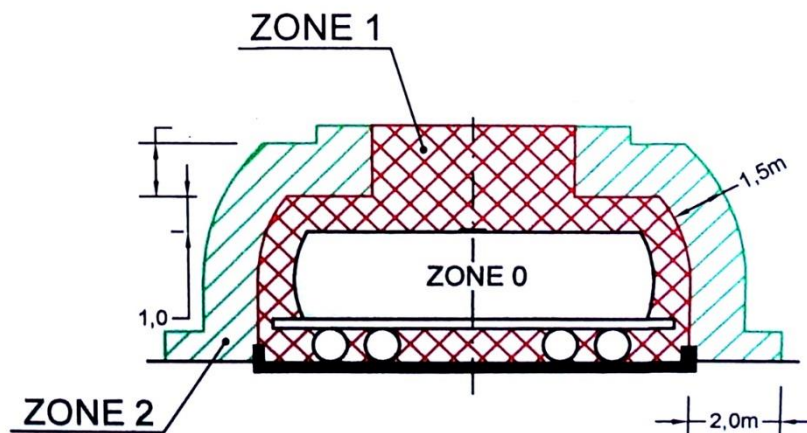


Hazardous areas

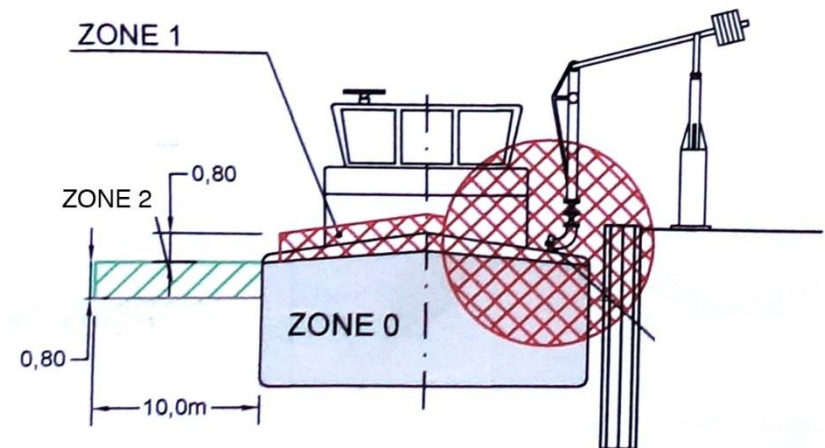
- Zone 0** Area, in which exists constantly, over long periods or frequently a hazardous atmosphere as a mixture of air and flammable gases, fumes or fog.
- Zone 1** Area, in which during normal operation occasional a hazardous atmosphere as a mixture of air and flammable gases, fumes or fog can arise.
- Zone 2** Area, in which during normal operation a hazardous atmosphere as a mixture of air and flammable gases, fumes or fog usually not or only temporary appears.

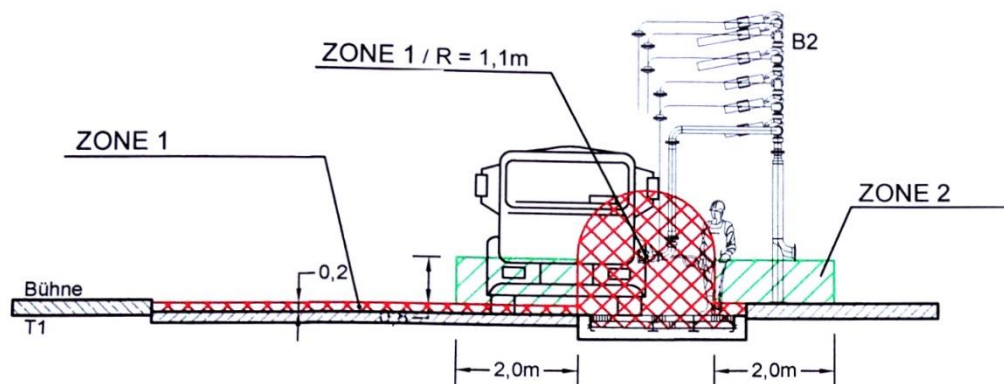


Hazardous area at a road tanker

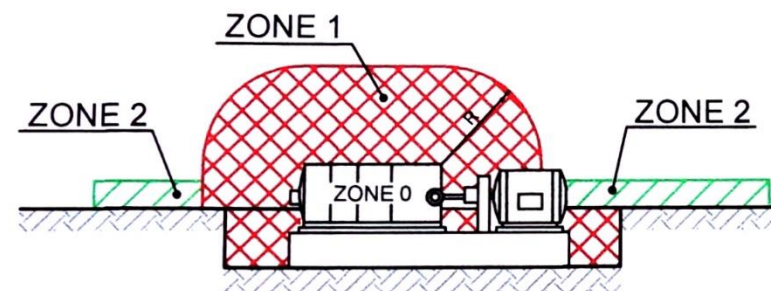


Hazardous areas at a shipping pier

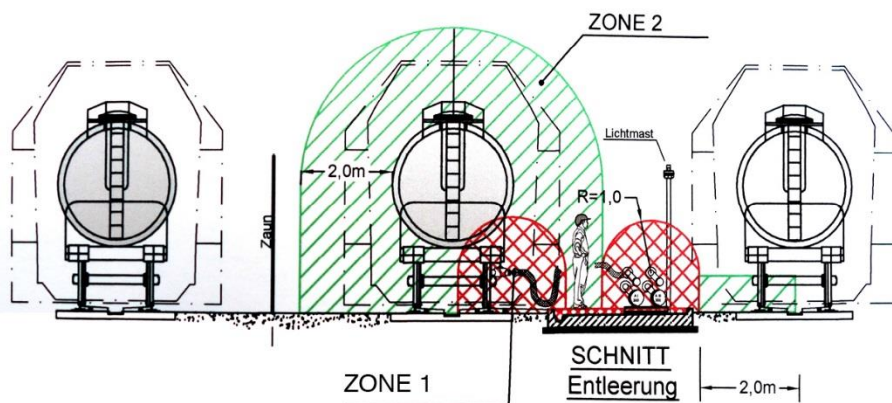
Emplacement per ship (Volume flow = 800m³/h)



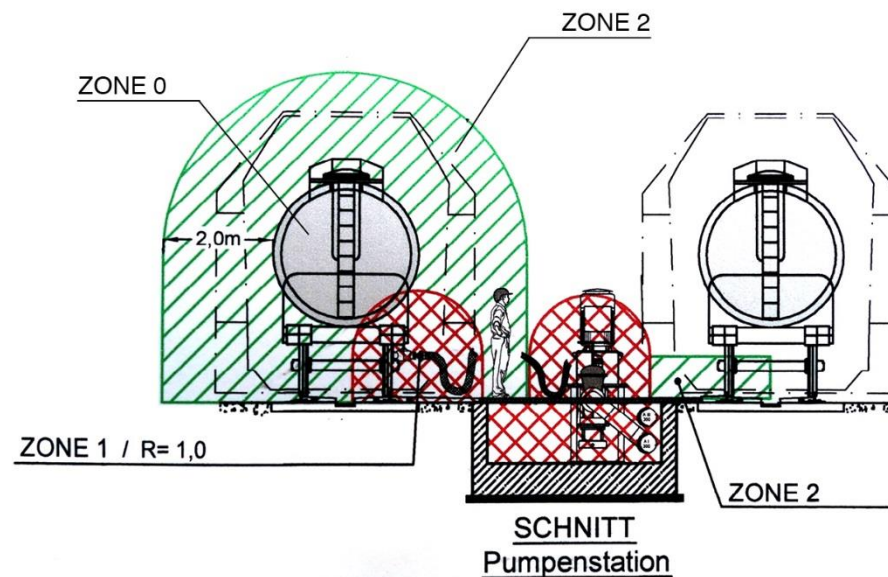
Hazardous areas at bottomloading
